All source certification meets GHG Protocol Scope 2 Guidance Quality Criteria. This is not a REGO certificate. REGO certificates are held by energy suppliers for Fuel Mix Disclosure. The low carbon electricity that we buy for Renewable tariffs and products is supplied into the National Grid. Customers receive that electricity through the National Grid, not directly from low-carbon generators.

The Carbon Trust has assured that the electricity supplied for the year ended in 31st March 2020 under the following products – Renewable for Business, Select Renewable, Clean Renewable and UK Renewable – all of which are under the umbrella of the “Renewable tariffs” is 100% covered by Renewable Certificates that have been obtained and retired by EDF, in line with the WRI GHG Protocol Scope 2 Guidance (2015).



*100% of the electricity supplied is renewable, backed by certificates of renewable energy guarantees of origin. Emission factor compliant with the GHG Protocol Scope 2 Guidance used to be used for the 'market-based method'.
