

Special Traffic Arrangements for Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th September 2024

The University looks forward to welcoming you and your family members to Durham and to your operation in ensuring the arrival of all new students on Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th September.

To ensure a smoother freshers arrivals weekend process, the University has introduced special controls for traffic on the Peninsula and you will require an access permit for your college.

If you are travelling to Durham by car, please read the below information carefully:

 All vehicles traveling to Peninsula colleges are asked to report to Mountjoy Centre, Stockton Road, Durham DH1 3UP at their specific time slot communicated by the college. For a Google Maps link Click <u>Here.</u> What 3 words, the location is ///flies.wasp.invite

Please note: There will be temporary road works in place at the A167 Rushyford Roundabout to C34 Ricknall Lane Junction for the full Freshers arrivals weekend. If you are travelling to Durham and using the A1, we recommend taking exit 62 off the A1 and following the A690 into the city.

- Park as directed by the University stewards on duty.
- Once parked in the holding area at Mountjoy Centre, we recommend that only one person from your party should go and collect a permit, allowing you to access the Peninsula area, where your college is based.
- Please return to your vehicle as soon as you have been given your access permit, you will then
 be directed to the relevant queue for your college. Security will then send vehicles up in order
 of college time slot.
- Once at your college, you will have 15 minutes to unload your car, after 15 minutes you will
 need to remove your vehicle immediately. Please follow the one-way system off the Peninsula
 and across Prebends Bridge.
- The University has made provision for free parking on the Mountjoy site, should you wish to use
 this. After crossing Prebends Bridge, turn left onto Quarryheads Lane, cross the roundabout,
 and go straight across the temporary road works onto Stockton Road. You can then enter the
 Mountjoy site via the entrance on the right. Click Here for a Google maps link.

- Please display the permit clearly in the car windscreen whilst on the Peninsula and in the University car park.

Once you have parked at one of these locations off the Peninsula, you (and your guardians) will have all the time you wish to look around the city. Please note that if you use a public car park, you must purchase a **pay and display** ticket or use the PayByPhone app.
