Prohibited Electrical Items

The following items are prohibited from use in College in the bedrooms and the communal areas, unless provided by the College. Items used for the preparation of hot/cold food and drink, including (but not exclusively):

- Toaster unless provided by College
- Kettle unless provided by College
- Microwave unless provided by College
- Toastie maker
- Coffee percolator
- George Foreman grill or similar
- Rice cookers using non-UK compliant cables and adaptors
- Deep fat fryer
- Pressure cooker
- Slow cooker
- Clothes airers

Other items include:

- Fridge and freezer (unless provided/authorised by College for medical reasons)
- Mains powered Fairy lights battery powered lights are permitted
- Multi socket block adapters extension leads are ok,, but must have no more than 4 sockets and
 must have a fuse. Items with separate cables must have UK complaint cables, international
 adaptors are not allowed. PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THE ELECTRICAL GUIDANCE IN KITCHENS
- Large TV's over 32 inches
- All portable heating, cooling, or air purifying equipment (unless provided by
- College)
- Candles, wax burners, incense burners and plug-in air fresheners
- Electric blankets no exceptions
- Electric clothes dryers
- Pets or animals of any kind
- Any equipment using a gas canister
- Any other items deemed unsuitable by a member of College staff.

If you are unsure about the suitability of any equipment, please contact a member of College staff. Non-compliant equipment will be removed and held securely until the end of the academic year.
