Diploma of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission

- 1. This programme is available at **SPIRITUS THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE** in part-time (3 year) mode of study for ordinands on a three-year training programme (M); there is also a slightly different part-time pathway for those who embark on studies as independent students but are subsequently accepted for a two-year ordinand training programme and so do a hybrid of independent and ministerial training (H). A third, four-year route (I) is available for those who remain as independent students. The fourth route (D) is for those who complete a Cert (180) before ordination as a deacon and wish to continue to complete their Diploma during their curacy. All modules listed for a pathway are compulsory for that pathway and 'ALL' means it is compulsory for all pathways. Modules not listed for a pathway are optional for it. A module may appear in more than one list but may only be taken once.
- 2. Most of these modules are taught through a blend of face-to-face classes (in person or on zoom) supported to varying extents by small groups meeting for reflective practice seminars; those marked * also have a significant amount of supported online learning, both synchronous and asynchronous. The exceptions are the Independent Learning Projects which are supervised in person or by zoom, and those modules marked ** which are entirely supported learning online, although some elements may be synchronous.
