

Foundation Award in Theology, Ministry and Mission

1. This programme is available at **SPIRITUS THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE** in a part time (1 year) mode of study by independent students (I), ordinands (O) or Readers (R).
2. Most of these modules are taught through a blend of face-to-face classes (in person or on zoom) supported to varying extents by small groups meeting for reflective practice seminars; those marked * also have a significant amount of supported online learning, both synchronous and asynchronous. The exceptions are the Independent Learning Projects, which are supervised in person or by zoom, and those modules marked ** which are entirely supported learning online, although some elements may be synchronous.
