







What is deep learning?

- Large Language Models trained on large datasets to analyse patterns & predict text based on this




The sigmoid curve






Gartner Hype Cycle

Their actions turned one of the best-known symbols of New York — its signature yellow cabs — into a financial trap for thousands of immigrant drivers. More than 950 have filed for bankruptcy, according to a Times analysis of court records, and many more struggle to stay affoot.


"Nobody wanted to upset the industry," said David Klahr, who from 2007 to 2016 held several management posts at the Taxi and Limousine Commission, the city agency that oversees calls. "Nobody wanted to kill the golden goose."

New York City in particular failed the taxi industry, The Times found. Two former mayors, Rudolph W. Gullani and Michael R. Bloomberg, placed political allies inside the Taxi and Limousine Commission and directed it to sell mediallious to help them balance budgets and fund priorities. Mayor Bill de Blasto continued the policies.

Under Mr. Bloomberg and Mr. de Blasio, the city made more than \$855 million by selling taxi medallions and collecting taxes on private sales, according to the city.

But during that period, much like in the mortgage lending crisis, a group of industry leaders enriched themselves by artificially inflating medallion prices. They encouraged medallion buyers to borrow as much as possible and ensuared them in interest—only leans and other one-sided deals that often required them to pay hefty fees, forfeit their legal rights and give up most of their monthly incomes.


Stochastic Parrots




